I have read, understand, and agree to the following:

- Acceptance into the Voluntary Public School Choice Program is a privilege that, when granted, allows a student to attend a school other than his/her zoned school. School administration at the School of Choice reserves the right to revoke the choice privilege at any time.
- If you live in Flagler and were granted school choice in a previous year, you do not have to reapply yearly, as long as you are staying in the same Flagler school.
- Transfers between districts must reapply yearly. (See Transfer Between Districts Request Form.)
- If a student moves to a School of Choice and has 5 or more unexcused absences, any level 3 or 4 violations of the Code of Student Conduct, or any failing grades, the choice privilege may be reviewed for revocation.
- Parents are responsible to provide transportation to the School of Choice. **FCSB does not transport Choice Students.**
- Students may not receive the choice privilege during an active discipline consequence (ex. OSS, Tier 3 placements, alternative education placements, etc.)
- Students may not receive the choice privilege while in Tier 3 of the MTSS process for behavior and/or academics.
- Middle and high school students must be on track with their class cohort, i.e. they may not be retained. Elementary students will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- ESE students' IEP requirements must be available at the School of Choice. Director must approve transfer.
- Middle and high school parents should discuss the possible academic impact of transferring to another school with the child's counselor prior to application. Note: due to scheduling differences and varying courses offered, promotion may be impacted.
- Parents of athletes should discuss the possible impact on playing eligibility with your child's athletic director prior to application. Approval to attend the school of choice does not guarantee athletic eligibility.
- If a school receives more requests for choice than the school can accept, approval will be based on a lottery system.
- Preference will be given to students whose siblings already attend a school of choice.
- Notice of acceptance or denial will be mailed by the first week of August.
